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The County Commission of Brooke County, West Virginia met in adjourned session this $10^{\rm th}$ day of October, 2023 at 10:30 a.m. at the Courthouse.

The Commission held their preliminaries before the meeting including a prayer and the pledge of allegiance.

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A copy of the following correspondences was given to each of the Commissioner's for their review:

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Commissioner Diserio made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Wise and unanimously passed to approve the minutes from October 3, 2023.

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Commissioner Diserio made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Wise and unanimously passed to approve an In-House Budget Transfer for the Tax Office in the amount of \$5,000.00.

Commissioner Wise made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Diserio and unanimously passed to approve a lease service agreement for a new copier xerox machine in bookkeeping. This will actually be a savings of \$47.44 per month. New monthly total \$310.97 (Old agreement \$358.42)

There was also a donation in the amount of \$1,500.00 from MPLXIF to help with the cost associated with the purchased of two (2) laptops for Andy Nickerson, Director EMA and Jeff Luck, Assistance Director EMA.

Commissioner Diserio made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Wise and unanimously passed to sign the EMS salary enhancement fund invoice. A letter from the State of West Virginia Department of Health & Human Resources Bureau of Public Health Office of Emergency Medical Services. With a notification of your allotted award under the Emergency Medical Services Salary Enhancement Fund in the amount of \$143,763.21. The Commission has noted they must see how these funds will need to be allocated and used, they have contacted the WV State Auditor's Office on how to move forward on this matter.
