Budget Sheet and Group Medical Plan Analysis

The annual Medical Insurance has increased 54.6% - \$693,065.52 making the new annual premium \$1,963,521.96.

A total of fourteen (14) other providers were ask to give a Medical Insurance quote all declined other than one (1) which was Highmark. Their quote was 56% higher than the Health Plan, our current provider.
